BPIE has released a report arguing that deep renovation of buildings, must urgently obtain a legally binding definition at EU level and become standard practice in order to reach climate goals and combat rising fuel prices and energy poverty. This should be included in the European Commission's revised EPBD, expected before the end of 2021.
